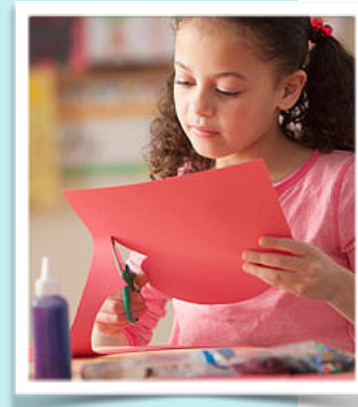

TRAINING THE BRAINS OF THE CITIZENS OF THE FUTURE: HOW LANGUAGE CLASSES CAN SUPPORT DEVELOPMENT OF 21ST CENTURY SKILLS - JACQUELINE MARTIN , GSE - PEARSON

Today's young people are surrounded by digital technologies: the internet, social media, mobile devices. Generation Z is tech-savvy – but what impact is this having on the skills they need to acquire for the future? And how can the educators of today prepare the global citizens of tomorrow?

Whilst few would deny that English is often a “passport” to a better education, better opportunities, even a better job, the presenter will draw on research that suggests learning English is much more powerful than simply the acquisition of a second language. The process of learning a language trains the brain to think in certain ways. The presenter will argue that language teachers are uniquely positioned to build the type of skills that are now being considered as key for the future by focusing on a set of 21st century skills: creativity, critical thinking, collaboration and creativity and how these can be addressed in a young-learner language classroom. The future may be uncertain – but it is bright for language teachers and learners!
